

WHMIS – A CLOSER LOOK AT THE MSDS

This class is designed for those regularly dealing with chemicals, such as in a manufacturing environment, or for those concerned with hazardous chemicals in their work place.

- Overview, history and application of WHMIS Legislation
- Supplier responsibilities Classification and explanation of symbols, supplier labels and preparation of Material Safety Data Sheets
- Employer responsibilities Workplace labels, decanted products, availability of MSDS, worker education
- Worker rights and responsibilities
- Laboratories and Construction Projects (if applicable)
- Enforcement by Ministry of Labour
- Overview of a sample MSDS
- Detailed analysis of a sample MSDS
- Explanation of Control Measures Engineering controls, work practices, administrative controls and personal protective equipment controls

There will be a brief knowledge verification test (quiz) at the end of the course in the form of yes/no and multiple choice questions. Instructor provides a notes sheet, so only pens will be required by the attendees. Successful participants receive a wallet card.
